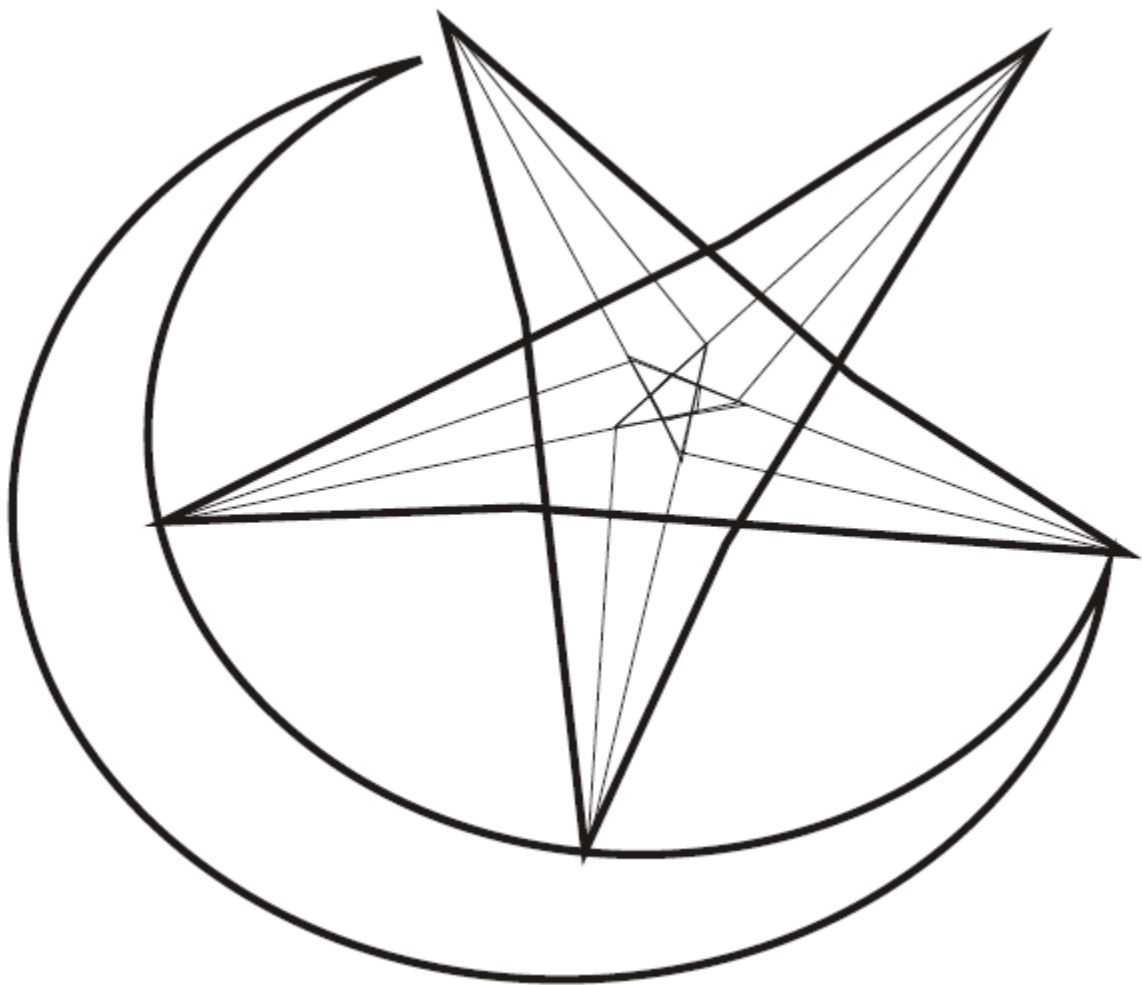

T is for 'Taraweeh'



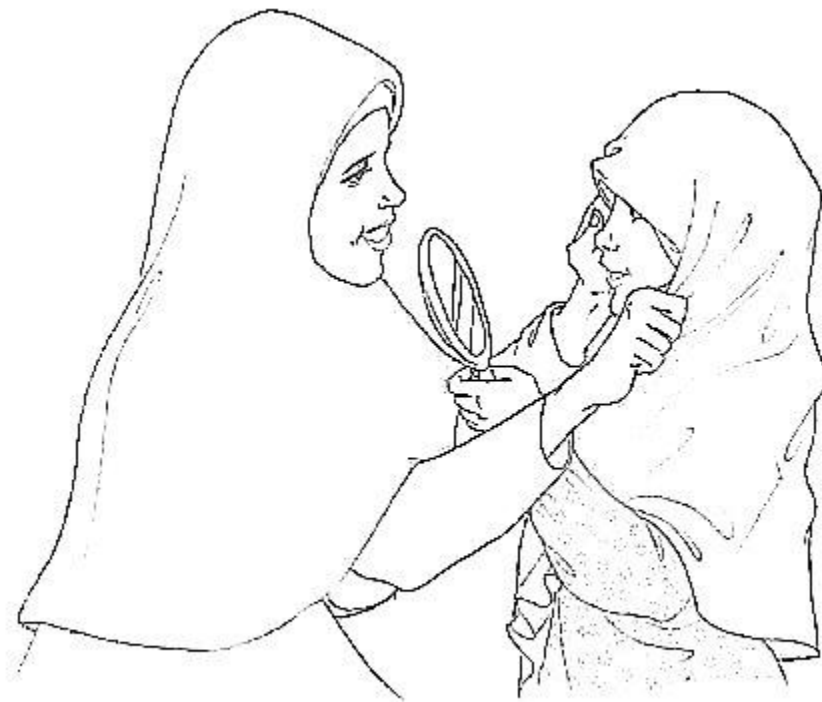
We pray taraweeh prayers

Like showing kindness to others

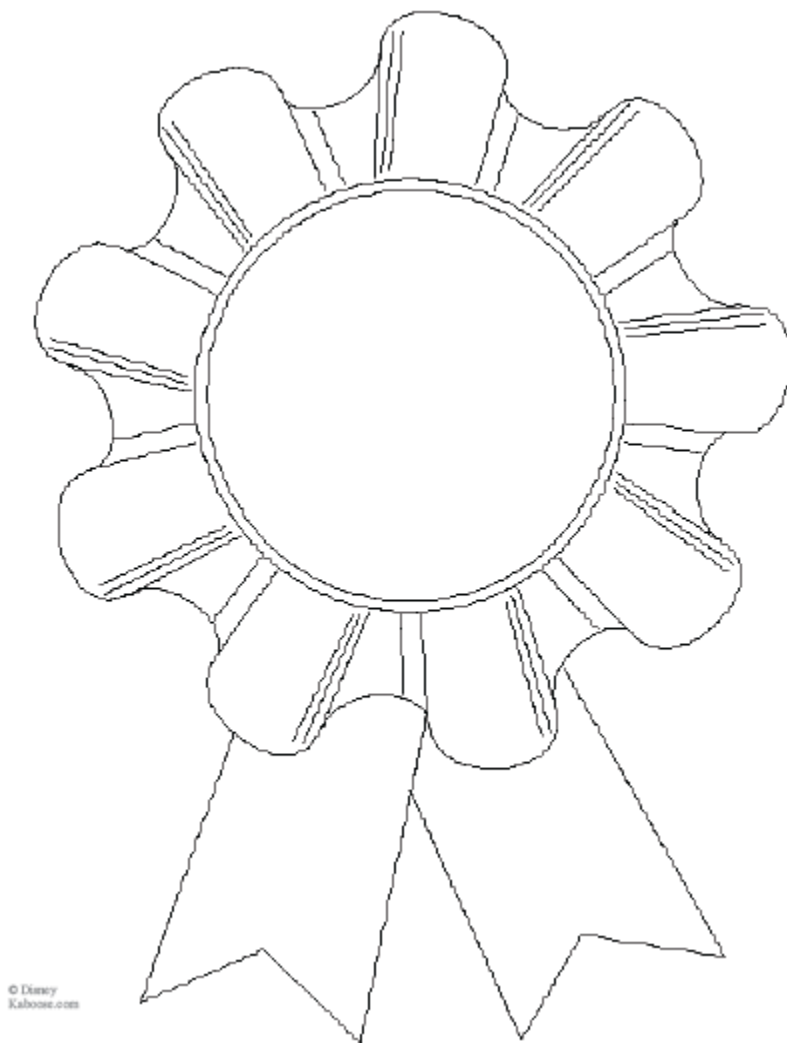
W is for 'Wudu'

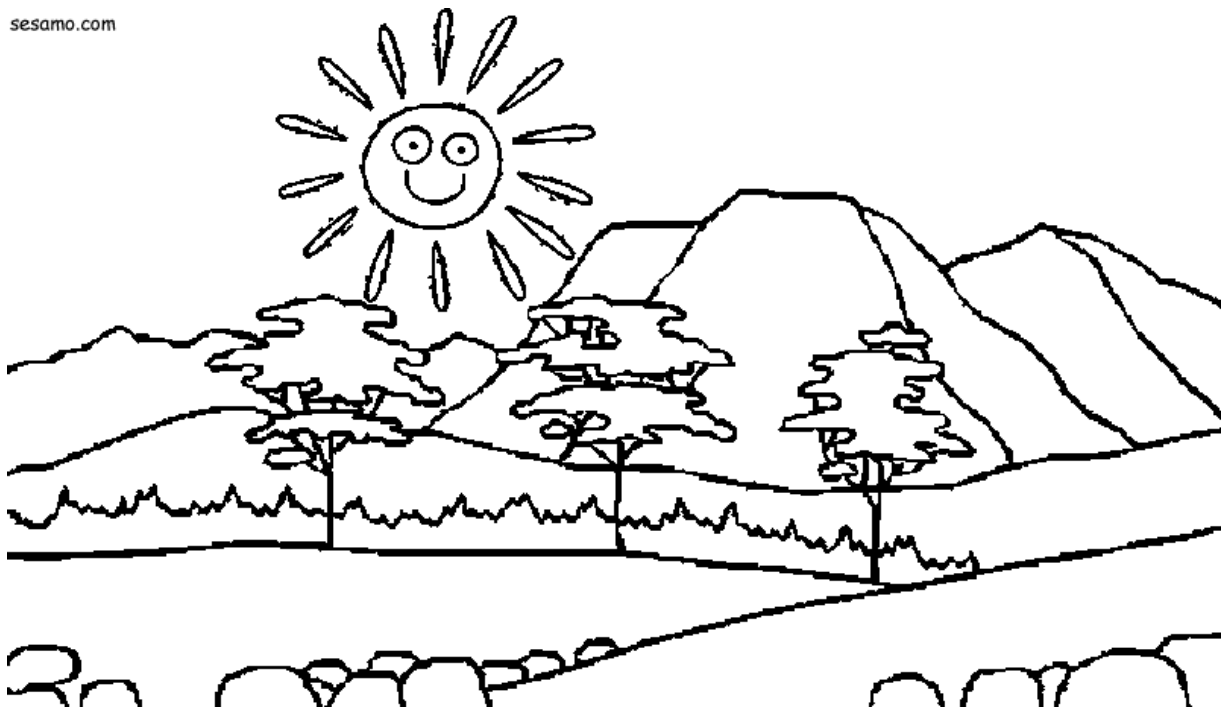
