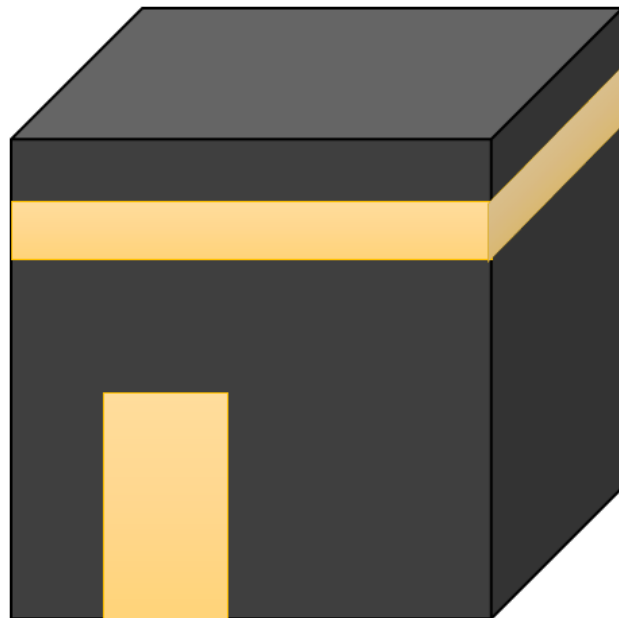
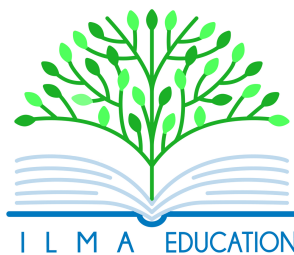
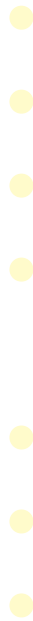

QUOTE OF THE DAY

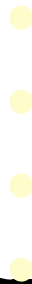

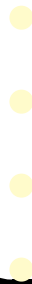

[Qur'an: Chapter 3, Verse 92]

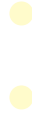

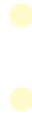

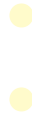
