Hadith Pertaining to the Qur'an:

Narrated ‘Abdullāh bin Abbās رَضِيَ اللهُ عَنْهُمَا: Allāh’s Messenger صَلَّى اللهُ عَلَيْهِ وَعَلَى آلِهِ وَسَلَّمَ, said, “Jabril عَلَيْهِ السَّلَامُ recited the Qur’an to me in one way.
