2. Why is Masjid Al Aqṣā important? Tick the correct statements.

Masjid Al Aqṣā is mentioned by name in the Qur'an. It is described as blessed from within and so is its surrounding areas.

The Prophet Muhammad ﷺ mentioned the great virtues of Al Aqṣā.

It is the third most sacred Masjid on this earth.

Many prophets were born or died in Palestine; such as Ibrahīm عليه السلام, 'Ēsā عليه السلام, and Mūsā عليه السلام.

It was the station of Al Isrā' Wal Mi'rāj

It was the first Qiblah for Muslims.

Praying in Masjid Al Aqṣā is rewarded 250 times more than regular prayer.

The first Masjid to be built was the Ka'bah and the second Masjid was Masjid Al Aqṣā.

3. Read the following Ahadith of the Prophet Muhammad ﷺ about Masjid Al Aqṣā.

Abu Dharr رضي الله عنه reported that he asked the Prophet ﷺ, “O Messenger of Allah, which Masjid was built first on earth?” The Prophet ﷺ replied, “The Sacred Masjid of Makkah.” Abu Dharr again asked, “Which was next?” The Prophet ﷺ said, “The Masjid Al-Aqṣā.” Abu Dharr رضي الله عنه further asked, “How long was the period between the building of the two Masājid?” The Prophet ﷺ said, “Forty years.” Apart from these, offer your prayers anywhere when it is time to pray, as excellence lies in it.” (Al-Bukhari)

It was narrated that Abu Dharr رضي الله عنه said: We were discussing when we were with the Messenger of Allah ﷺ, which is better, the Mosque of the Messenger of Allaah ﷺ or Bayt al-Maqdis (Jerusalem). The Messenger of Allah ﷺ said: “One prayer in my mosque is better than four prayers offered there (in Bayt al-Maqdis), and what a good place of prayer it is”. (Al-Hākim, 4/509)

Abu Hurayrah رضي الله عنه relates that the Prophet ﷺ said, “You should not undertake a special journey to visit any place other than the following three Masājid (with the expectation of receiving greater reward); the Sacred Masjid of Makkah (Ka’bah), this Masjid of mine (the Prophet’s Masjid in Madinah), and Masjid Al Aqṣā (of Jerusalem).” (Muslim)

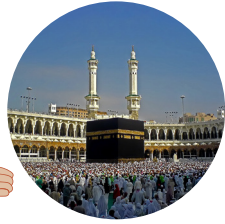

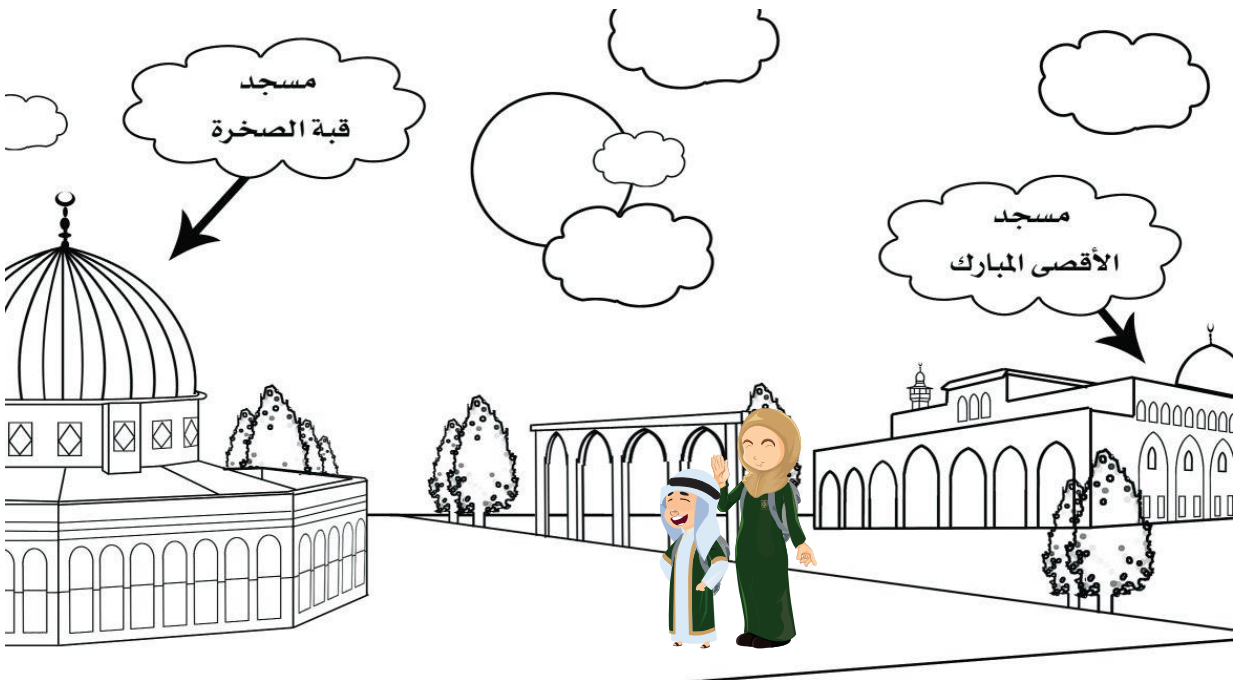
