
JE History

More recently (from 1996) the space was renovated to make place for worshippers. It's used for itikaf during Ramadhan.



The masjid was converted into stables for horses for the Crusaders when they took over this site.

The stables were cleared out by Salahuddin Ayyubi and used as a basement again.



Masjid Al-Aqsa was built at the time of Adam and has been rebuilt and developed many times.



During the Ummayad period, this space was converted to a more usable space.



In ancient history, the location of Marwani Masjid was part of the main outside wall, this area may have been used for storage.




I'm going to go to Marwani Masjid to do Itikaf. It's so huge and has so many levels and arches.



Prophet Isa was a prophet of Allah. He was born miraculously and given many miracles.




Yahya


The Visit

The Room


It wasn't allowed for girls to be in service of Masjid Al-Aqsa.

Maryam Allah had commanded her. Instead, she pointed to her baby.


A miracle happened, baby Isa started to talk and told the people that he was a Prophet of Allah.
