

# How To Use This Book

The concept of the “wheel” activities is simple: One circle with a “window” is placed on top of another same-sized circle. As the top wheel is turned around, different pictures are revealed at the window sequentially. This is especially effective for learning about concepts in order, as in salah, sawm and hajj. You can test the child’s knowledge about the concept by asking what comes next before you turn the wheel.

## **Material Requirements:**

You will need the following for each of the activities.

- Colour pencils, crayons, textas
- 1 Pair of scissors
- 1 Split pin
- 2 A4 cardboards (optional)

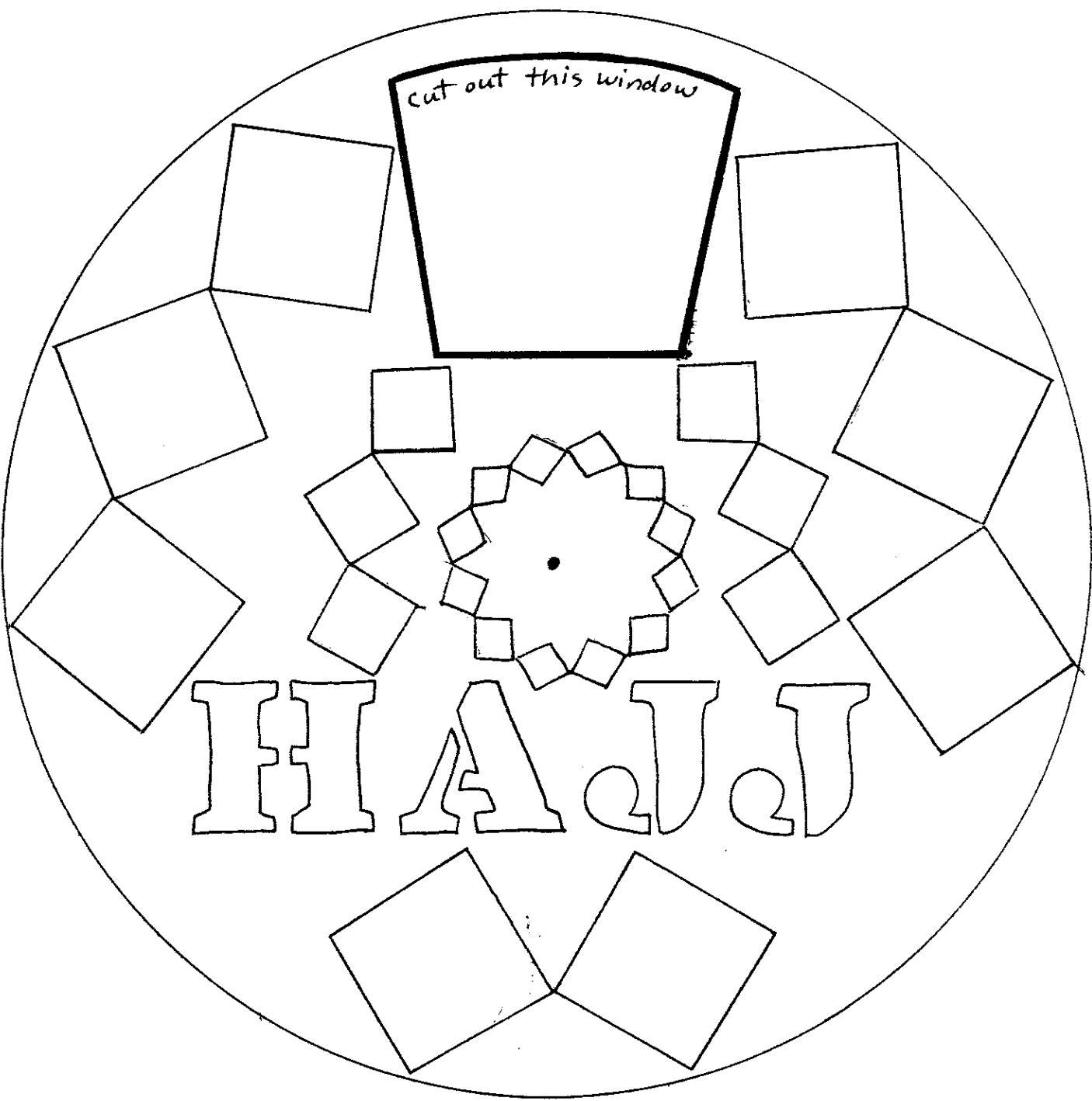
## **Method:**

The following instructions are for all the activities.

- 1 Photocopy the pair of wheels onto A4 paper or cardboard.
- 2 Let the child colour the pictures.
- 3 Cut the circles and the “window”.
- 4 Place the circle with the “window” directly on top of the other circle. Push the split pin through the dots on both circles.
- 5 The child can then turn the top circle around clockwise.

The teaching strategies in this book are suggestions for enhancing the child’s learning of the five pillars. Select from the list the most appropriate ones for the child.
