

Hajj : Lesson 1 of 4

The Prophet, sallallahu ^alayhi wa sallam, said:

بنى الإسلام على خمس شهادة أن لا إله إلا الله وأنّ محمداً رسول الله، وإقام الصلاة، وإيتاء الزكاة، وحج البيت، وصوم رمضان

It means: “The most important matters of Islam are five: Testifying that no one is God except Allah and that Muhammad is the Messenger of Allah, performing Prayers, paying Zakah, performing Hajj, and fasting Ramadan.”

The Kabah was first built by Prophet Adam, may peace be upon him. It is located in Makkah.

The Hajj event happens once a year, during the month of Dhul-Hijjah.

Muslims from all over the world travel to Makkah to perform Hajj. Some travel by planes, some travel by train, and even some even travel by foot! Even though they all speak different languages, they look differently and come from different places, during Hajj, they all wear white and do the exact same thing in obedience to Allah.

We will soon learn more about Hajj and the things Muslims do during this very special time of year!


- Build a Kabah using construction paper





Hajj : Lesson 2 of 4

Talbiyah - تلبية الحجاج

O Allah, I obey Your Order. I obey You one time after the other. O Allah, I obey Your Order. You are the One Who does not have any partner. I obey You one time after the other.	لبيك اللهم لبيك، لبيك لا شريك لك لبيك
You are the One Who deserves to be praised and thanked. Every endowment is from You. You are the One attributed with Dominion.	إِنَّ الْحَمْدَ وَالنَّعْمَةَ لَكَ وَالْمَلِكَ
There is no partner with You.	لا شريك لك

During Hajj, Muslims must do certain things to complete the Hajj. For example:

- 1) Standing on the mountain of Arafat:
 - a) Arafat is a big mountain that the Muslims stand on during Hajj. This is a very important day in Hajj and it is Sunnah for those who are NOT at Hajj to fast this day.
 - b) The Prophet may peace and blessings be upon him said: الحج عرفة - It means: The greatest integral of Hajj is one's presence in Arafat.
- 2) Making Tawaf:
 - a) This is to go around the Kabah, usually saying the Talbiyah.
 - b) They start the Tawaf near the black stones, putting the Kabah to one's left side.
 - i) Black Stones: the black stones are originally from Paradise. They used to be white and glowing but after many years, they lost their color and are now called the Black Stones.
 - c) Muslims make Tawaf 7 times around the Kabah.
- 3) Making Sa^y:
 - a) There are two mountains near the Kabah, they are called: Safa and Marwa.
 - b) Muslims walk between these 2 mountains 7 times, that is called Sa^y.

For older kids, you can talk about the Integrals of Hajj. (8+ years)

During Hajj, the Muslims do certain things called Integrals of Hajj. Integrals of Hajj are things that the Muslims must do for the Hajj to be valid. That means they cannot skip these things, for the Hajj to be complete, they must do these things:

1. Intention - that means, in their hearts, they say that they are now starting Hajj.
2. Physical presence at mountain of Arafat
3. Tawaf
4. Sa^y
5. Shaving the head or trimming the hair - at the end of the Hajj journey, men shave their heads or trim their hair if they don't wish to shave and the women trim the hair.
6. Observing the order; in performing most of these five (5) integrals.


Hajj Activities

The best NIGHT of the year is The Night of Al-Qadr (during Ramadan.)

The best DAY of the year is The Day of Arafah, Yawm Arafah.

Yawm Arafah is the 9th of Dhul-Hijjah. It's the day before Eidul-Adha!!

On this day, the Muslims stand on the mount of Arafah. Millions of Muslims stand on this mountain, if you look at it, the mountain looks white because of all the people standing there that day.

This part of Hajj is the most important integral of Hajj. The Prophet, may peace be upon him said: الحج عرفة

“Al-Hajju Arafah” - this means that this integral is the most important one of Hajj. Can you memorise this Hadith?


It is recommended to fast this day. The Prophet, may peace be upon him, informed us that fasting this special day sincerely erases the sins of the year before it AND erases the sins of the year after it.

If you are old enough to fast, plan to fast that day - remember it's the day before EID!

Can you help these kids find their way to the Kabah?





The 10th of Dhul-Hijjah is EID! Eidul-Adha

When you wake up on Eid, kiss your parents' hands and give them a hug. Visit your grandparents or call them if they live far. Call your aunts and uncles. It is recommended to contact our family members to keep ties during special occasions like Eid!

Some of the recommended things to do on Eid are:

- 1) Take a shower
- 2) Wear something new, if you can.
- 3) Use your Siwak to brush your teeth.
- 4) Put some perfume.
- 5) Go to the Masjid to pray the Eid prayer.
- 6) Congratulate your Muslim sisters and brothers.
- 7) Exchange gifts, if you can. A gift can be some dates! It is always nice to think of our Muslim friends and give them something to make their hearts happy.

On this day, Muslims slaughter an animal like a lamb to feed the Muslims.




Color the picture.
