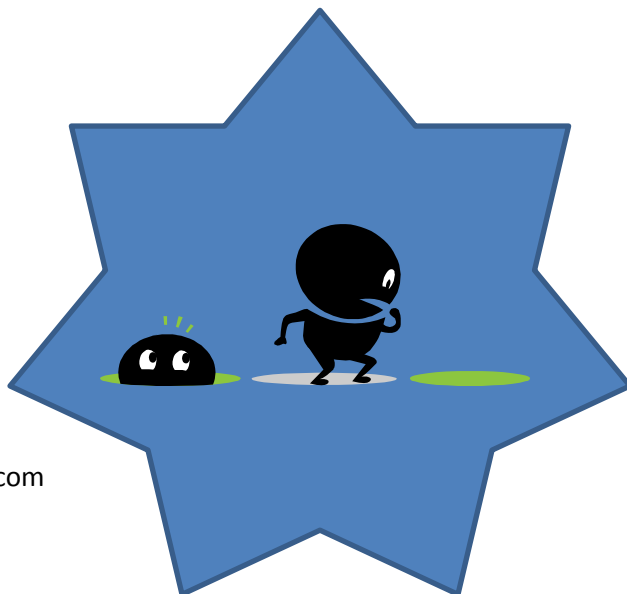
1.Noon has a sukoon نْ.

3.Noon decides to hide (I mean, what would you do if letters were following you), and **only his ghunna remains**.



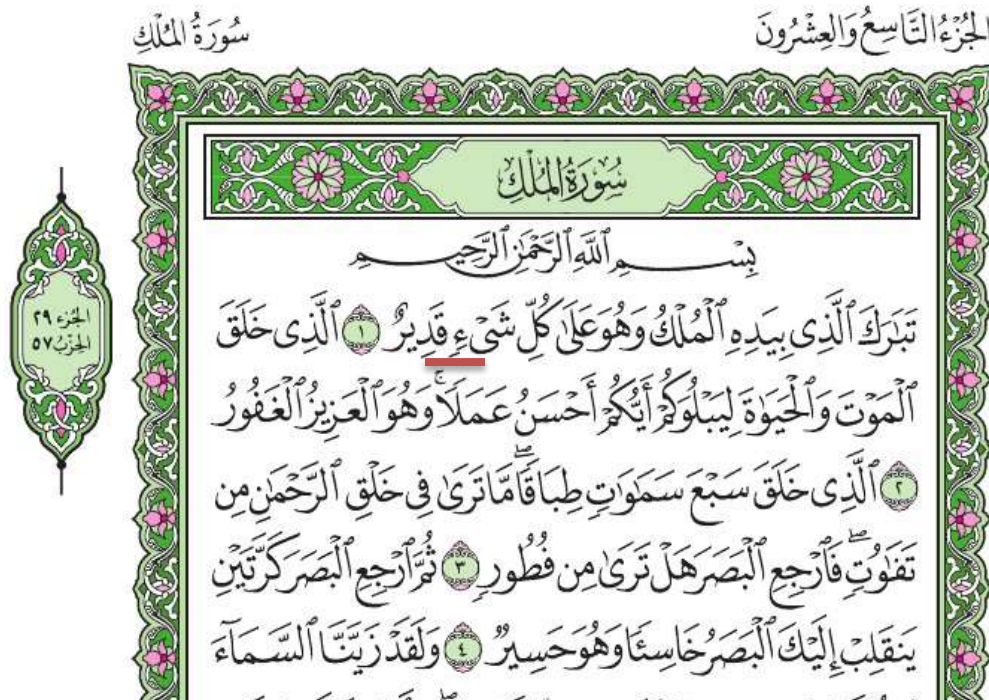
Letters of Ikhfa
