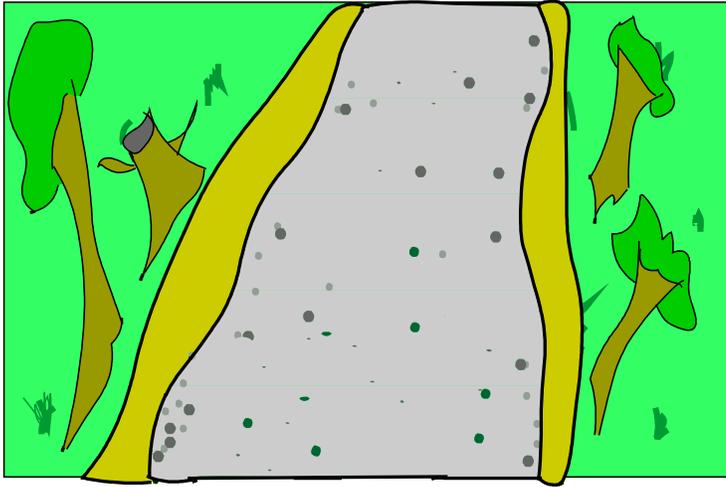

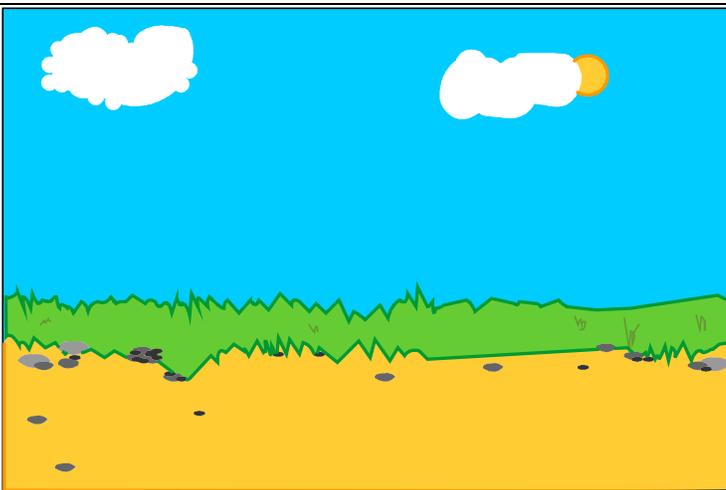


When Moses (As) found out there was a man who existed who had knowledge, which he was unaware of, what did he do?

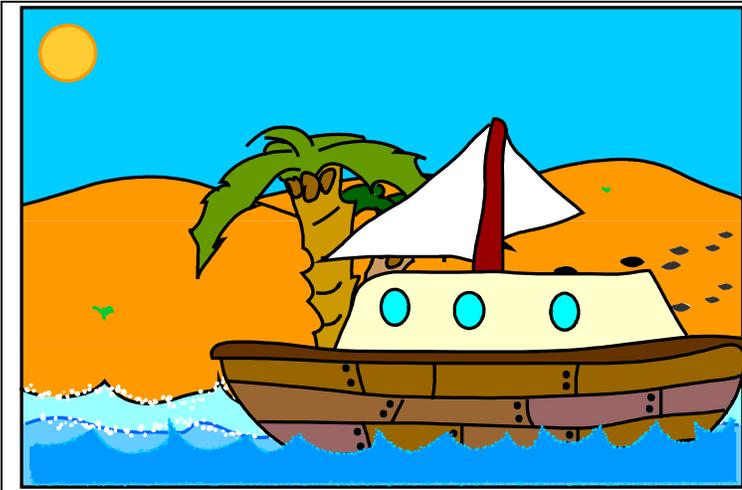


What was the name of Moses (As) servant boy?

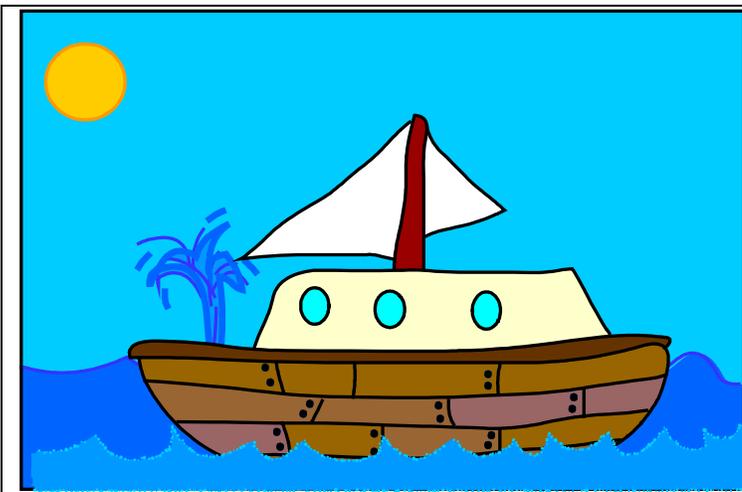
Where did Moses and his servant boy lose the fish?



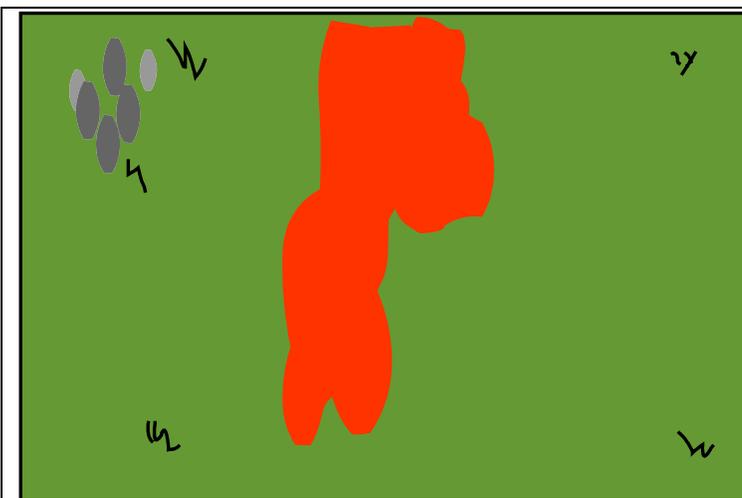
Does Al-Khadir have knowledge of all matters even the unseen?



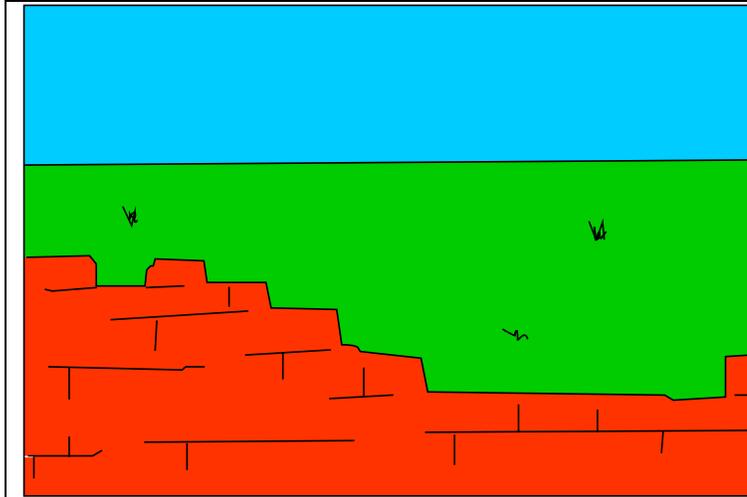
Why did al-Khadir and Moses (as) not pay the people of the boat any money?



Why did al-Khadir scuttle the boat of the people who provided transport for them without cost?

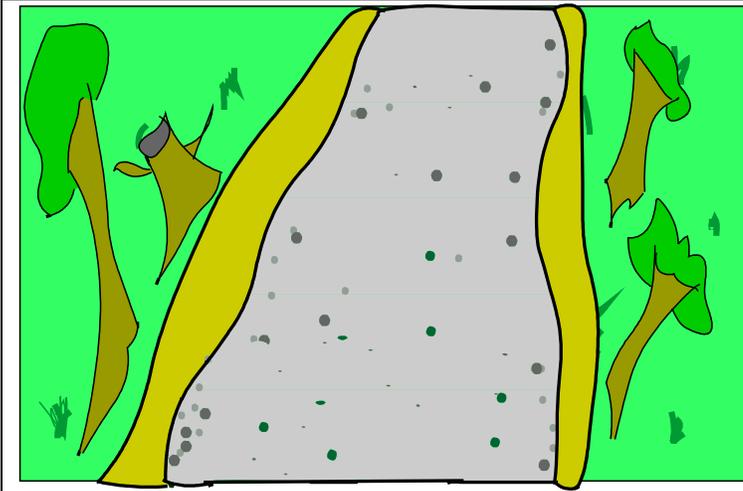


Why did al-Khadir kill a young boy?



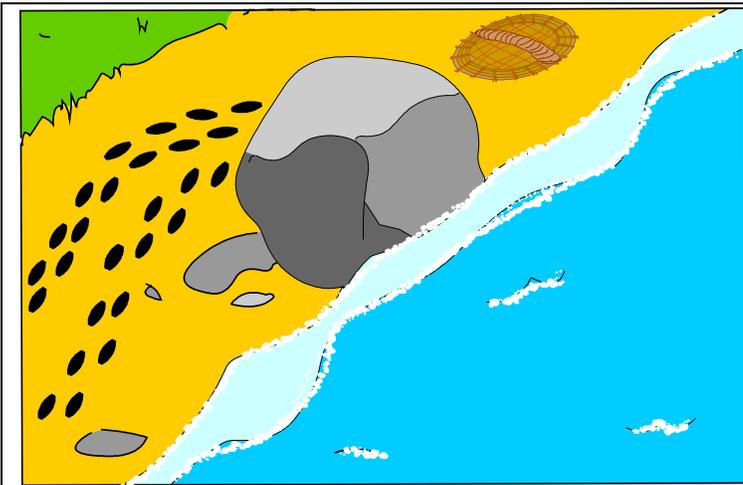
Why did al-Khadir rebuild the wall for free in a town of people who refused them food and drink?

## Answers



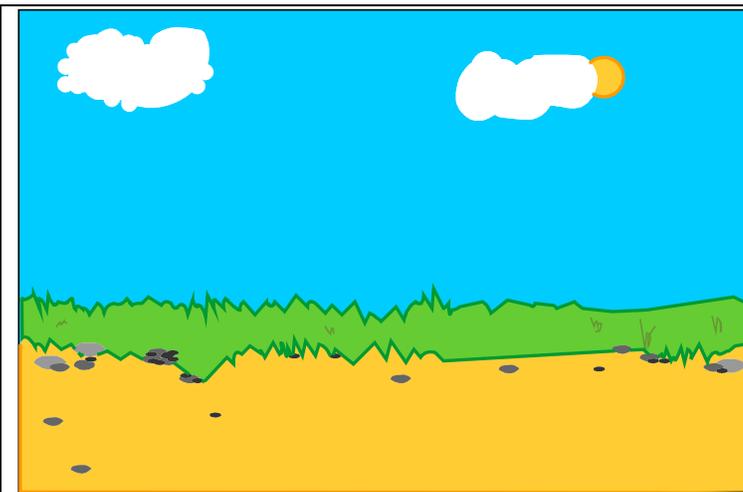
Moses sets off immediately to seek knowledge..

So Moses set out along with his (servant) boy, Yusha' bin Nun and carried a fish in a large basket ...



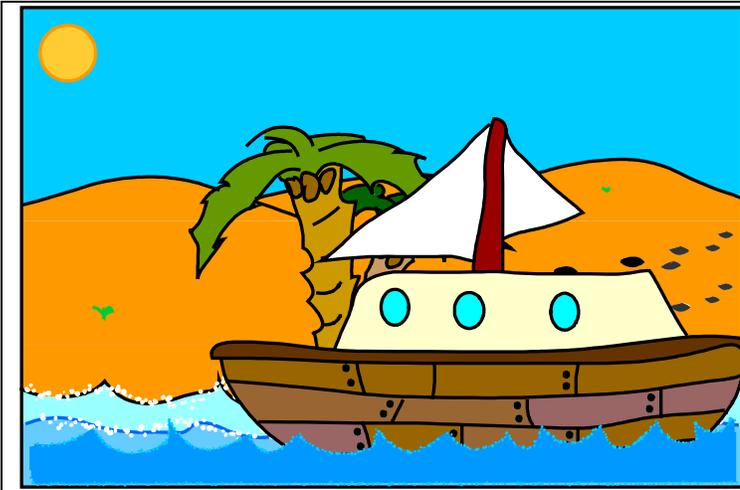
1. Yusha' ibn Nun (As)

2. At the rock where the two seas meet. This is where they lost the fish and met the man (Al-Khadir, As) covered in a garment.



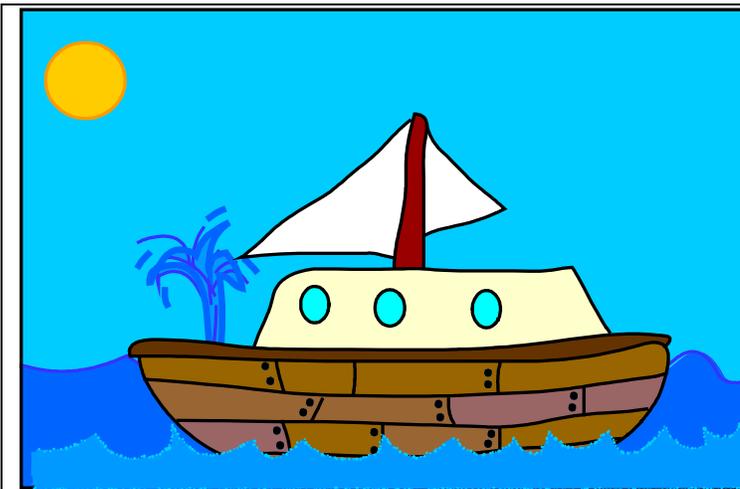
Al-Khadir only has knowledge that Allah (swt) has made him aware of and denies that he has knowledge of all matters.

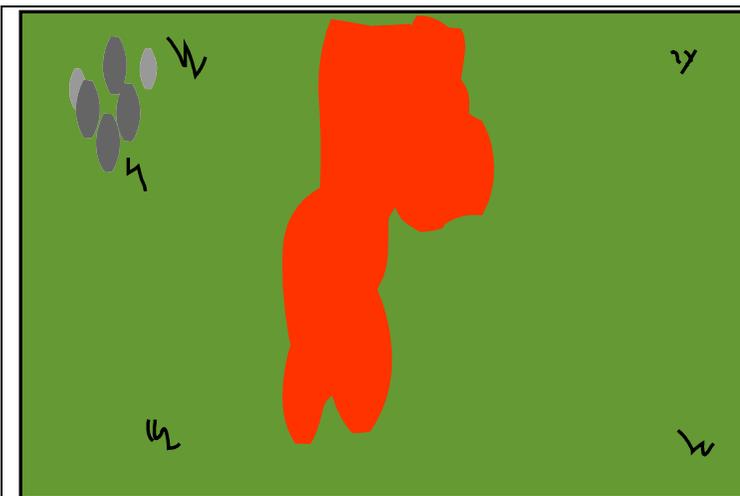
Why did al-Khadir and Moses (as) not pay the people of the boat any money?

This highlights their dependency upon Allah to provide for their means and their lack of interest in seeking worldly gains.



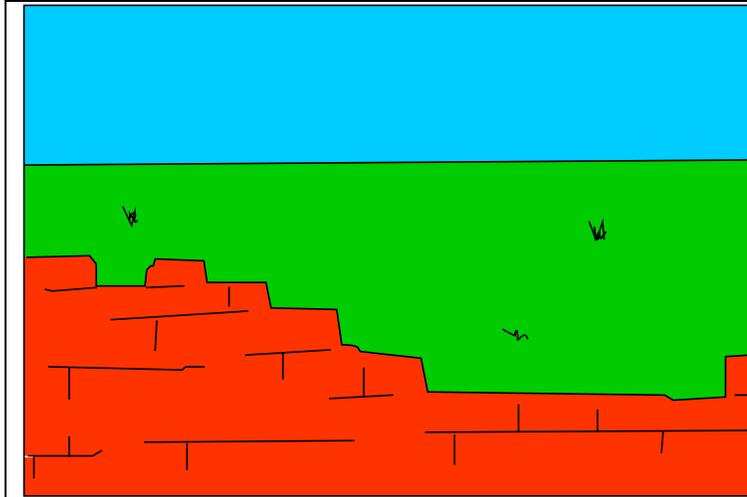
Why did al-Khadir scuttle the boat of the people who provided transport for them without cost?
